



INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN CONNECTION WITH THE FIGHT AGAINST THE SARS-COV-2 PANDEMIC

As required by art. 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we are informing you about the processing of your personal data by Heidelberg University in the context of the measures against the SARS-CoV-2 (coronavirus) pandemic; these measures are based on the Ordinance of the State Government on Infection Protection Measures against the Spread of the SARS-CoV-2 Virus (Corona Ordinance) of 28 July 2020, in the amended version effective from 6 August 2020.

Heidelberg University is obligated to collect and process your personal information under the Corona Ordinance. At the request of the local health office or police authority, your personal information will be transmitted to these institutions in accordance with §§ 16 and 25 of the Infection Protection Act, provided this is necessary to trace potential paths of infection.

Your right to object according to art. 21 par. 1 GDPR

You have the right to object at any time, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to processing of your personal data that is based on art. 6 par. 1 cl. 1(e) GDPR (processing of data in the public interest).

Data Categories of personal data processed by the university	– First and last name, address, date and time of attendance and – if available – telephone number (§ 6 Corona Ordinance) – No contact with a person infected with coronavirus within the last 14 days and no sign of typical symptoms of a coronavirus infection (§ 7 Corona Ordinance)

Recipients to whom the data required for the respective purpose are disclosed	– Internal recipients: the person at the university in charge of the respective event – External recipients: the local public health office or the local police authority, in accordance with §§ 16 and 25 of the Infection Protection Act
7. Transmission to third countries particularly non-EU countries	No data transmission to third countries
8. Storage times	4 weeks
9. Data sources in cases where the data were not collected from you	Personal data concerning you are not collected from third parties
10. Your data protection rights	– Right to obtain information about whether or not data concerning you are being processed (art. 15 GDPR, § 9 State Data Protection Act) – Rectification of your data (art. 16 GDPR) – Erasure of your data (art. 17 GDPR, § 10 State Data Protection Act) unless the university is legally obliged to store the data – Right to data portability (art. 20 GDPR) – Right to lodge a complaint with the responsible supervisory authority for data protection (Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information for the State of Baden-Württemberg)
