



INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN CONNECTION WITH THE FIGHT AGAINST THE SARS-COV-2 PANDEMIC

As required by art. 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we are informing you about the processing of your personal data by Heidelberg University in the context of the measures against the SARS-CoV-2 (coronavirus) pandemic; these measures are based on the Ordinance of the State Government on Infection Protection Measures against the Spread of the SARS-CoV-2 Virus (Corona Ordinance – CoronaVO) of 23 June 2020 in the respective latest version and the Ordinance of the Ministry of Science, Research and the Arts on Infection Protection Measures against the Spread of the SARS-CoV-2 Virus within the ministry’s area of responsibility (Corona Ordinance on Degree-related Operations and the Arts – CoronaVO Degree-related Operations and the Arts) of 16 September 2020.

Heidelberg University is obligated to collect and process your personal information under the Corona Ordinance and the CoronaVO Degree-related Operations and the Arts. At the request of the local health office or police authority, your personal information will be transmitted to these institutions in accordance with §§ 16 and 25 of the Infection Protection Act, provided this is necessary to trace potential paths of infection.

Your right to object according to art. 21 par. 1 GDPR

You have the right to object at any time, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to processing of your personal data that is based on art. 6 par. 1 cl. 1(e) GDPR (processing of data in the public interest).

Personal data concerning you are not collected from third parties

– Right to obtain information about whether or not data con-
cerning you are being processed (art. 15 GDPR, § 9 State
Data Protection Act)
– Rectification of your data (art. 16 GDPR)
– Erasure of your data (art. 17 GDPR, § 10 State Data Protection
Act) unless the university is legally obliged to store the data
– Right to data portability (art. 20 GDPR)
– Right to lodge a complaint with the responsible supervisory au-
thority for data protection (Commissioner for Data Protection and
Freedom of Information for the State of Baden-Württemberg)
